

HOUSE No. 1037

Bill accompanying the petition of Clarence N. Grey and another for legislation to remove certain restrictions from a parcel of land at the corner of Arlington and Newbury streets in the city of Boston. Cities. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To release a Certain Restriction affecting Certain Land at the Corner of Arlington and Newbury Streets, Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The parcel of land in Boston bounded :
2 Easterly on Arlington street one hundred and twelve
3 feet ; southerly on Newbury street one hundred and
4 eighty-six feet ; westerly on land now or formerly of
5 Standish by a line passing through the middle of the
6 brick partition wall one hundred and twelve feet ; and
7 northerly on a street or passageway sixteen feet wide one
8 hundred and eighty-six feet ; also the fee and soil of so
9 much of said passageway as lies southerly of its middle
10 line and between the east and west boundary lines of
11 the above described parcel extended ; or however other-

12 wise said premises may be bounded or described and be
13 any or all of said measurements more or less, is hereby
14 released from the operation and effect of the restriction
15 heretofore imposed on said land in deeds from the com-
16 monwealth that no cellar or lower floor of any building
17 shall be placed more than four feet below the level of the
18 mill dam as fixed by the top surface of the hammered
19 stone at the southeast corner of the emptying sluices.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
