

HOUSE No. 1059

Bill accompanying the petition of W. H. McClary for legislation relative to the killing of foxes. Fisheries and Game. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Killing of Foxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Whoever kills a fox not in captivity
2 shall, upon providing satisfactory evidence of such kill-
3 ing, be entitled to receive from the treasurer of the town
4 the sum of three dollars; and all sums so paid out shall
5 be repaid to the town treasurer by the treasurer of the
6 county in which said town is situated: *provided*, that a
7 sworn statement thereof shall be transmitted by the town
8 treasurer to the treasurer of said county.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
