

Bill accompanying the petition of Harry M. Eames and others for legislation to exclude the town of Andover from the Salisbury beach reservation. Harbors and Public Lands. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To exclude the Town of Andover from the Salisbury Beach Reservation District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section three of chapter seven hundred and fifteen of
2 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and twelve is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in lines four and five,
4 the word "Andover", — so as to read as follows: — *Sec-*
5 *tion 3.* The jurisdiction and powers of said commission
6 shall extend to, and may be exercised in, the cities of
7 Newburyport, Haverhill, Lawrence and Lowell, and the
8 towns of Salisbury, Amesbury, Merrimac, Methuen,
9 North Andover, Boxford, Georgetown, Groveland and
10 West Newbury. The said cities and towns shall consti-
11 tute the Salisbury Beach Reservation District.
