

HOUSE No. 1083

Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas H. Condon and another for legislation to provide double-time compensation for certain employees of railroad corporations for work performed on Sundays and holidays. Labor. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

AN ACT

To provide Double-Time Compensation for Certain Employees of Railroad Corporations for Work Performed on Sundays and Holidays.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All steam railroads within the common-
2 wealth, who require the service of car repair men, car
3 inspectors, car oilers and car cleaners on Sundays and
4 holidays, shall pay said employees double-time pay for
5 work performed on such Sundays and holidays.

1 SECTION 2. Any official of the railroad company
2 who violates the provisions of this act shall be fined
3 fifty dollars for each person so employed.
