AN ACT

To provide for Continuance in Cases against Children.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Whenever any child is before any court for being
- 2 neglected, wayward, delinquent, truant, an habitual ab-
- 3 sentee and habitual school offender, or stubborn, the court
- 4 may continue the case for such length of time as shall
- 5 seem best for the interest of said child.
