

Bill accompanying the petition of Parker H. Nason for legislation to exclude the towns of West Newbury and Georgetown from the Salisbury Beach reservation district. Harbors and Public Lands. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To exclude the Towns of West Newbury and Georgetown from the Salisbury Beach Reservation District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter seven hundred
2 and fifteen of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 twelve is hereby amended by striking out the word
4 " Georgetown ", in line five, and the words " and West
5 Newbury ", in line six, and by inserting after the word
6 " Boxford ", in line five, the word: — and, — so as to
7 read as follows:— *Section 3.* The jurisdiction and
8 powers of said commission shall extend to, and may be
9 exercised in, the cities of Newburyport, Haverhill, Law-
10 rence and Lowell, and the towns of Salisbury, Amesbury,
11 Merrimac, Methuen, Andover, North Andover, Boxford
12 and Groveland. The said cities and towns shall consti-
13 tute the Salisbury Beach reservation district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
