Bill accompanying the petition of E. E. McGrath for legislation relative to the use of hat pins. Legal Affairs. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Use of Hat Pins.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to
2 wear in public a hat pin which projects more than two
3 inches from the crown of the hat in which it is inserted,
4 unless the point of the hat pin is protected by a cap or
5 other device in such manner as to prevent the injury of
6 persons coming in contact therewith.

1 SECTION 2. Violation of this act shall be punished by
2 fine or imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
