## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

### AN ACT

To provide for the Construction by the Metropolitan Park Commission of a Public Bath House on the Boulevard at Wollaston Beach in the City of Quincy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct and there-  
3 after to maintain a public bath house with the necessary  
4 appurtenances on land heretofore taken or hereafter to  
5 be taken by the commission on the boulevard at Wollas-  
6 ton beach in the city of Quincy known as Rufe's Hum-  
7 mock. The commission may establish rules and regula-  
8 tions and make reasonable charges for the use of the  
9 bath house, and all sums received for such use shall be  
10 paid to the treasurer and receiver general, and shall be

11 placed by him to the credit of the metropolitan park  
12 expense fund, and may be expended by the said com-  
13 mission in addition to any loans or appropriations  
14 authorized for park purposes.

1 SECTION 2. For the above purpose the sum of twenty  
2 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated to be paid from  
3 the treasury of the commonwealth out of the metropoli-  
4 tan parks maintenance fund, and to be repaid to the  
5 commonwealth by the cities and towns in the metropoli-  
6 tan district in accordance with the provisions of chapter  
7 four hundred and sixty-four of the acts of the year  
8 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine.

3 SECTION 1. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
