

HOUSE No. 1586

Bill accompanying the recommendations of the Board of Commissioners on Fisheries and Game (House, No. 1583). Fisheries and Game. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to Certificates of Registration of Hunters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eleven of chapter six hundred and
2 fourteen of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and eleven, as amended by chapter three hun-
4 dred and seventy-nine of the acts of the year nine-
5 teen hundred and twelve, is hereby amended by
6 striking out the last part of the section, beginning
7 with the word " every ", in the eighth line, and in-
8 serting in place thereof the following:— *And the*
9 *certificate of any person who shall be convicted of*
10 *a violation of the game laws or of any provision of*
11 *this act shall be void, and his certificate shall im-*
12 *mediately be surrendered to the officer who secures*
13 *such conviction and the officer shall forthwith for-*

14 *ward said certificate to the commission on fisheries*
15 *and game, who shall cancel the same and notify the*
16 *clerk issuing the certificates of the cancellation of*
17 *such certificate, and no person shall be entitled to*
18 *receive a certificate during the period of one year*
19 *from the date of conviction. Any certificate issued*
20 *to such person within one year of the conviction*
21 *under this act shall be void and such certificate shall*
22 *be surrendered on demand of any officer authorized*
23 *to enforce the game laws, — so that the section as*
24 *amended shall read as follows: — Section 11. Any*
25 *person who makes a false representation as to birth-*
26 *place, requirements of identification, or of facts rel-*
27 *ative to property qualifications, or naturalization,*
28 *or otherwise violates any provision of this act shall*
29 *be fined not less than ten nor more than fifty dol-*
30 *lars, or be imprisoned for not more than thirty days,*
31 *or may be punished by both such fine and imprison-*
32 *ment. And the certificate of any person who shall*
33 *be convicted of a violation of the game laws or of*
34 *any provision of this act shall be void, and his cer-*
35 *tificate shall immediately be surrendered to the*
36 *officer who secures such conviction and the officer*
37 *shall forthwith forward said certificate to the com-*
38 *mission on fisheries and game, who shall cancel the*
39 *same and notify the clerk issuing the certificates of*
40 *the cancellation of such certificate, and no person*
41 *shall be entitled to receive a certificate during the*
42 *period of one year from the date of conviction. Any*
43 *certificate issued to such person within one year of*
44 *the conviction under this act shall be void and such*
45 *certificate shall be surrendered on demand of any*
46 *officer authorized to enforce the game laws.*
