

HOUSE No. 1738

Bill accompanying the petition of Timothy Leary for legislation relative to his expenses as medical examiner for the county of Suffolk for the year 1912. Public Service. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Expenses of Timothy Leary Medical Examiner of Suffolk County for the Fiscal Year Nineteen hundred and Twelve.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the county of Suffolk to Timothy Leary
3 medical examiner of said county the sum of three hun-
4 dred and fifty-five hundredths dollars for expenses in-
5 curred during the fiscal year nineteen hundred and
6 twelve.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
