Resolve accompanying the petition of A .G. Cumnoek for legislation relative to the Lowell Textile School. Education. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

RESOLVE

In favor of the Lowell Textile School.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth to the trustees of the
3 Lowell textile school the sum of thirty-four thousand
4 four hundred and thirty-eight dollars and forty-three
5 cents, including deficiency of nineteen hundred and
6 twelve, to be applied to the purposes of the school for
7 the last half of the school year, beginning January first,
8 nineteen hundred and thirteen, and ending June thirtieth,
9 nineteen hundred and thirteen, and the further sum of
10 fifty thousand dollars for the same purposes for the fiscal
11 year of said school beginning July first, nineteen hun-
12 dred and thirteen, and ending June thirtieth, nineteen
13 hundred and fourteen. These two sums being required
14 for the maintenance of said school for eighteen months
15 because of the change of the fiscal year of the corporation

16 from calendar year to school year by chapter four hun-
17 dred and forty-five of public acts of nineteen hundred
18 and twelve.

19 The city of Lowell is hereby authorized to raise by
20 taxation and pay to said trustees such sum of money,
21 not exceeding nine thousand dollars, as may be necessary
22 to provide free evening instruction at said school for
23 residents of Lowell.
