AN ACT

Relative to the Price of Water.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Water sold to the consumer by any
2 city or town or by any private corporation in this
3 commonwealth shall be sold at a flat rate, and the
4 consumer who uses a small quantity shall pay no
5 more in proportion than the consumer who uses a
6 large quantity.

1 SECTION 2. Violations of the provisions of this
2 act shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten
3 nor more than one hundred dollars for each offence.
