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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

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### RESOLVE

To provide for Reimbursing the Old Colony Railroad Company for Rent paid for the Commonwealth Pier Property after the termination of Obligation.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 Port of Boston Fund by the treasurer and receiver gen-  
3 eral the sum of eleven thousand six hundred sixty-six  
4 dollars and sixty-seven cents as a refund to the Old Colony  
5 Railroad Company, for rent paid for the commonwealth  
6 pier property for the months of July and August, in the  
7 year nineteen hundred and twelve, under the provisions  
8 of a lease dated November one, nineteen hundred and  
9 ten, the obligation to pay said rent having been terminated  
10 as of July one, nineteen hundred and twelve, by the pro-  
11 visions of an agreement or contract executed by the  
12 directors of the port of Boston and the Old Colony Rail-  
13 road Company, the New York, New Haven and Hartford  
14 Railroad Company, lessee of the Old Colony Railroad  
15 Company and the Boston and Maine Railroad.
