AN ACT

To repeal an Act relative to the Time for the Bringing of Suits to recover on Certain Bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter four hundred
2 and eight of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
3 and six, as amended by section two of chapter two
4 hundred and eighty-seven of the acts of the year
5 nineteen hundred and nine, and by chapter four
6 hundred and fifty of the acts of the year nineteen
7 hundred and nine, is hereby further amended by
8 striking out, at the end thereof, the words " at any
9 time within one year after the breach of such
10 bond ", so as to read as follows:— *Section 3.* Suit
11 to recover on a bond required to be filed under the
12 provisions of this act, or of any acts in amendment
13 thereof or in addition thereto, may be brought by or
14 upon the relation of any party aggrieved, in a court
15 of competent jurisdiction.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
