The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the use of Rooms or Halls in School Buildings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the useful-
2 ness of the public school property the school committee of
3 any city or town may conduct such educational and recre-
4 ation activities in or upon school property under its con-
5 trol, and shall allow the use thereof by individuals and
6 associations, subject to such regulations as the school
7 committee shall establish, for such educational, recrea-
8 tion, social, civic, philanthropic and similar purposes as
9 the committee may deem to be for the interest of the
10 community, provided that no admission fee is charged
11 and that such use shall not interfere or be inconsistent
12 with the use of the premises for school purposes.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not apply to the city of
2 Boston.
