RESOLVE

Granting a County Tax for the County of Middlesex.

- 1 *Resolved*, That the following sums are hereby appropri-
- 2 ated for the expenses of the county of Middlesex for the
- 3 year nineteen hundred and thirteen.
- 4 For interest on county debt, a sum not exceeding twenty-
- 5 eight thousand dollars.
- 6 For reduction of county debt, a sum not exceeding
- 7 fifty thousand dollars.
- 8 For salaries of county officers and assistants, fixed by law,
- 9 a sum not exceeding forty-two thousand dollars.
- 10 For clerical assistance in county offices, a sum not exceed-
- 11 eighty thousand dollars.
- 12 For salaries and expenses of district and police courts, a
- 13 sum not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars.
- 14 For salaries of jailers, masters and assistants, and support
- 15 of prisoners in jails and houses of correction, a sum not
- 16 exceeding one hundred and forty-six thousand dollars.
- 17 For criminal costs in the superior court, a sum not exceed-
- 18 ing forty thousand dollars.
- 19 For civil expenses in the supreme judicial and superior
- 20 courts, a sum not exceeding ninety thousand dollars.
- 21 For trial justices, a sum not exceeding four thousand
- 22 dollars.

23 For transportation expenses of county and associate
24 commissioners, a sum not exceeding one thousand five
25 hundred dollars.

26 For medical examiners, inquests, and commitments of the
27 insane, a sum not exceeding twenty-two thousand dollars.

28 For auditors, masters and referees, a sum not exceeding
29 ten thousand dollars.

30 For repairing, furnishing and improving county buildings,
31 a sum not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars.

32 For fuel, lights and supplies in county buildings other
33 than jails and houses of correction, and for care of the
34 same, a sum not exceeding sixty-two thousand dollars.

35 For highways, including state highways, bridges and land
36 damages, a sum not exceeding sixty-five thousand dollars.

37 For law libraries, a sum not exceeding seven thousand
38 dollars.

39 For training schools, a sum not exceeding forty thousand
40 dollars.

41 For miscellaneous and contingent expenses of the current
42 year, a sum not exceeding six thousand five hundred dollars.

43 For pensions, a sum not exceeding eight thousand dollars.

44 And the county commissioners of said county are hereby
45 authorized to levy as the county tax of said county for the
46 current year, in the manner provided by law, the sum of
47 six hundred fifty-eight thousand nine hundred seventy-
48 eight dollars and eighty cents, to be expended, together
49 with the cash balance on hand and the receipts from other
50 sources, for the above purposes.
