AN ACT

To facilitate the Filing of Official Letters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of facilitating the filing
2 of official letters, such letters from the several depart-
3 ments of the commonwealth and from officials of counties,
4 cities and towns therein shall be written or printed, so
5 far as practicable, on paper having a width of eight and
6 one-half inches and a length of eleven inches.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 of October, nineteen hundred and thirteen.
