

HOUSE No. 2482

Bill accompanying the petition of the Mayor of the City of Waltham for legislation to authorize cities and towns to appropriate money for the care and disposal of certain animals and to employ incorporated humane societies for this purpose.

AN ACT

To increase the Sanitary Powers of Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be lawful for cities and towns to
2 make such appropriations as may be necessary for the
3 care and disposal of unlicensed or lost or abandoned dogs
4 and cats, and a city or town may contract with any society
5 situated in that city or town and duly incorporated for
6 the care or protection of dumb animals to care for and
7 dispose of unlicensed, lost or abandoned dogs and cats in
8 that city or town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
