

Bill accompanying the petition of the mayor of the city of Somerville that said city be authorized to incur indebtedness for the improvement of streets.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Somerville to incur Indebtedness for the Purpose of improving Streets.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Somerville, for the pur-
2 pose of paving public ways and portions of public
3 ways in said city, as its city council may from time
4 to time deem advisable, may incur indebtedness to
5 an amount not exceeding one hundred and fifty
6 thousand dollars and may from time to time issue
7 and sell notes or bonds therefor, payable in periods
8 of not exceeding fifteen years from the date of issue
9 and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding four
10 and one half per centum per annum.

1 SECTION 2. The debt and loan authorized by this
2 act and the notes and bonds issued therefor shall not
3 be considered or reckoned in determining the au-
4 thorized limit fixed by law of the indebtedness of
5 said city.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
