### RESOLVE

Relative to the Opening of the Connecticut River to Navigation.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of harbor and land commis-  
2 sioners is hereby authorized to urge before the congress  
3 of the United States, and any committee thereof, the pas-  
4 sage of legislation favorable to and for the purpose of  
5 reopening the Connecticut river to navigation. For the  
6 purposes of carrying out the provisions of this resolve  
7 said board may expend a sum not exceeding one thou-  
8 sand dollars.
