RESOLVE

1 *Resolved*, That the sum of five thousand two hundred
2 and twenty-two dollars and one cent be allowed and paid
3 for the purposes of repairing damage done by the recent
4 fire at the Rutland state sanatorium, as well as to include
5 one large fire extinguisher, and the cost of constructing a
6 small house to accommodate fire apparatus.
