RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Additions and Improvements at the Grafton Colony of the Worcester State Asylum.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding two
3 hundred and ten thousand five hundred dollars, to be ex-
4 pended at the Grafton colony of the Worcester state
5 asylum by the trustees of the asylum for the following
6 purposes:— For the Sinclair farm, house and barn, a
7 sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars; for two em-
8 ployees' cottages, a sum not exceeding sixteen thousand
9 dollars; for two bungalow cottages, a sum not exceeding
10 ten thousand dollars; for a chapel and recreation hall,
11 a sum not exceeding seventy-five thousand dollars; for
12 one boiler, a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dol-
13 lars; for one cow barn, a sum not exceeding nine thou-
14 sand dollars; for cold storage insulation, a sum not
15 exceeding sixteen thousand dollars; for filter bed en-
16 largement, a sum not exceeding twenty-five thousand dol-
17 lars; for the extension of hot and cold water system, a
18 sum not exceeding four thousand dollars; for an hydria-
19 tric outfit, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars; for
20 an addition to the service building, a sum not exceeding

21 twenty thousand dollars; for fireproofing rooms and fur-
22 nishings for the same in the administration building, a
23 sum not exceeding four thousand dollars; and additional
24 amount for a service building, central kitchen and dor-
25 mitory at colony number four, a sum not exceeding four-
26 teen thousand dollars.
