Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas A. Niland that laborers employed by cities and towns be granted vacations without loss of pay. Cities. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to Vacations of Laborers employed by Cities and
Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All persons classified as laborers, or doing
2 the work of laborers, and regularly employed by cities or
3 towns, shall be granted a vacation of not less than two
4 weeks during each year of their employment without loss
5 of pay.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
