Bill accompanying the petition of John A. Anderson relative to the keeping and use of pulmometers in police stations. Public Health. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To require the Keeping of Pulmometers in Police Stations and Headquarters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 In every police station or police headquarters main-
2 tained by any city or town there shall be placed and kept
3 at the expense of the city or town a pulmometer for use
4 in cases of accident and illness, and the same shall be
5 carried on all ambulances sent out by any city or town for
6 patients or injured persons. The pulmometers so kept
7 shall in cases of emergency be lent for use to any repu-
8 table physician who applies for the same, upon condition
9 that it shall be returned as soon as possible.
