Bill accompanying the petition of Thomas A. Niland that the members of the Public Service Commission be elected by the voters of the Commonwealth. Public Service. January 12.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Election of the Members of the Public Service Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The members of the public service commission now
2 in office shall cease to hold office on the day succeeding
3 the next annual state election and their successors shall
4 be nominated and elected by the voters of the common-
5 wealth at the said election. The nomination and election
6 of the members of the said commission shall be made in
7 the manner now prescribed by law for the nomination
8 and election of the secretary of the commonwealth.
