

HOUSE No. 352

Bill accompanying the petition of the mayor of the city of Boston relative to the Industrial School for Boys in said city. Education. January 13.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Industrial School for Boys in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The land situated on Halleck, Archibald
2 and Goldthwaite streets in the city of Boston, heretofore
3 taken by the board of street commissioners of said city
4 at the request of the public works department for a gar-
5 bage station, is hereby transferred to the control of the
6 school committee to be used for school purposes and to
7 be occupied by the industrial school for boys. The pay-
8 ment of all damages for the land so taken shall be met
9 by appropriation by loan or otherwise by the school com-
10 mittee in accordance with law, and any payments made
11 for said land shall be chargeable to the appropriation for
12 new school buildings, lands, yards and furnishings.

SECTION 2. Said board of street commissioners is further authorized to take in fee in accordance with the provisions of section thirty-one of chapter four hundred and eighty-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine additional land in said city so that the lot to be occupied by the industrial school for boys may exceed two acres but shall not exceed four acres in area.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
