RESOLUTIONS

Relative to the Frigate "Constitution."

- 1 *Whereas*, The people of Massachusetts have a great
2 love and veneration for the old frigate "Constitution,"
3 and are proud of her long record of victories; and
4 *Whereas*, It is fitting that she should pass her last days
5 at the place of her birth; therefore be it
6 *Resolved*, That the general court of Massachusetts re-
7 spectfully requests the senate and house of representatives
8 of the United States, and the honorable secretary of the
9 navy, to take such steps as may be necessary to make Bos-
10 ton the permanent resting place of the said frigate.
11 *Resolved*, That the members of congress from this
12 commonwealth be requested to make such efforts as they
13 deem proper to carry out the object of these resolutions.
14 *Resolved*, That copies of these resolutions be sent by
15 the secretary of the commonwealth to the senators and
16 representatives in congress from Massachusetts, and to
17 the honorable secretary of the navy.
