## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Salaries and Expenses  
of the Commission on Economy and Efficiency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are  
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the  
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the  
4 salaries and expenses of the fiscal year ending on  
5 the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred  
6 and fourteen, to wit:—

7 For the salaries of the members of the commis-  
8 sion, a sum not exceeding eighty-five hundred dol-  
9 lars. (Acts 1912, ch. 719, sec. 1.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$5,000.)

10 For the salaries of the secretary, experts, clerks  
11 and other assistants, and for such other expenses  
12 as may be deemed necessary and proper, a sum not  
13 exceeding twenty thousand dollars. (Acts 1912, ch.  
14 719, sec. 2.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$20,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
