AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of the Old Provincial State House in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sum of fifteen hundred dollars is
2 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 towards the maintenance of the old provincial state
5 house in the city of Boston, during the present fiscal
6 year, as provided for by chapter two hundred and
7 ninety-eight of the acts of the year nineteen hundred
8 and ten.

(Appropriation 1913, \$1,500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
