AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Development of the
Port of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of twenty-five thousand dol-
2 lars is hereby appropriated to be paid out of the
3 treasury of the commonwealth from the ordinary
4 revenue, to be expended by the directors of the port
5 of Boston, for the improvement of Boston harbor as
6 provided for by chapter six hundred and thirty-five
7 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and thir-
8 teen, the same to be in addition to any amount here-
9 tofore appropriated for the same purpose.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
