

HOUSE No. 672

Bill accompanying the petition of Henry J. Winslow for the construction of Alewife Brook parkway by the Metropolitan Park Commission. Metropolitan Affairs. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Construction of Alewife Brook Parkway
by the Metropolitan Park Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission is
2 hereby authorized to construct a parkway or boulevard on
3 the land already acquired for the purpose of constructing
4 the Alewife brook parkway, and to acquire such addi-
5 tional land as may be necessary to construct a boulevard
6 or parkway along said Alewife brook, and to expend
7 therefor the sum of four hundred and fifty-eight thousand
8 five hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. To meet expenditures made under au-
2 thority of this act the treasurer and receiver general,

3 with the approval of the governor and council, shall issue
4 scrip or certificates of indebtedness, bearing interest at a
5 rate not exceeding four per cent per annum, to the amount
6 of four hundred and fifty-eight thousand five hundred
7 dollars as an addition to the metropolitan parks loan,
8 series two. The treasurer and receiver general shall add
9 to the existing sinking fund to provide for the payment
10 of the said securities, and they shall be issued and addi-
11 tions to said sinking fund shall be assessed and collected
12 in accordance with the provisions of chapter two hun-
13 dred and eighty-eight of the acts of the year eighteen
14 hundred and ninety-four, and in accordance with the pro-
15 visions of chapter two hundred and eighty-three of the
16 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five and of
17 chapter four hundred and nineteen of the acts of the year
18 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and of the acts in
19 amendment thereof and in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
