

Bill accompanying the petition of Jacob Isaacs and others for the appointment of a court officer for the sessions of the Land Court. Public Service. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the Appointment of a Court Officer for the Sessions of the Land Court.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section sixteen of chapter one hundred
2 and twenty-eight of the Revised Laws is hereby amended
3 by striking out the whole of said section and inserting
4 in place thereof the following: — *Section 16.* The land
5 court in all matters over which it has jurisdiction may
6 enforce its orders or decrees in the same manner as de-
7 crees are enforced in equity, and upon request of the
8 justices of the land court, the sheriff of any county other
9 than Suffolk shall assign a deputy to attend the sittings
10 of the court in that county. The justices of the land court
11 shall appoint an officer for attendance upon the sessions
12 of said court in the county of Suffolk. The officer in
13 attendance upon said court in the county of Suffolk shall
14 receive in full for all services performed by him an an-
15 nual salary of seventeen hundred dollars which shall be
16 paid monthly by the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
