AN ACT

To extend the Powers of the Industrial Accident Board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The industrial accident board shall have
2 general supervision and regulation of and jurisdiction and
3 control over all insurance companies doing business under
4 the compensation act, so called, and the power to fix rates
5 and the right to examine the books of any mutual or
6 stock company writing compensation insurance.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 of September, in the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.
