Bill accompanying the petition of George J. Wall that certain employees of contractors on certain public works shall be citizens of the Commonwealth. Labor. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Citizenship of Certain Employees of Contractors doing Certain Work for the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 It shall be unlawful for any contractor, doing per-
2 centage work, so called, for the commonwealth, to
3 employ on the said work in any capacity except as
4 laborer any person who is not a citizen of the com-
5 monwealth. Violation of the provisions of this act
6 shall be punished by a fine of not less than five nor
7 more than five hundred dollars for each offence.
