AN ACT

To provide Clerical Assistance to the Clerk of the Police Court of Lawrence.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The clerk of the police court of Lawrence
- 2 shall be allowed not more than seven hundred and fifty
- 3 dollars each year for extra clerical assistance, upon the
- 4 certificate of the justice and the clerk that the work was
- 5 actually performed and was necessary, with the time
- 6 occupied in its performance and the names of the per-
- 7 sons by whom it was performed, and subject to the ap-
- 8 proval in writing of the county commissioners.
- 1 Section 2. So much of section sixty-seven of chapter
