## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Collection of Unpaid Taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section four of chapter six hundred and eighty-eight  
2 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen is  
3 hereby amended by striking out in line three the words  
4 "one year", and inserting in place thereof the words:—  
5 two years,— so as to read as follows:— *Section 4.* If  
6 taxes assessed after this act takes effect remain unpaid  
7 for fourteen days after demand therefor, the collector  
8 shall, within two years after the first day of October in  
9 the year of the assessment, levy the tax, together with all  
10 incidental charges and fees, in the manner provided by  
11 law.
