## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Relative to Second Assistant Assessors of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Second assistant assessors in the city of  
2 Boston who have served for at least three years in their  
3 present positions shall be eligible for appointment as first  
4 assistant assessors without a civil service examination.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
2 herewith are hereby repealed.
