Bill accompanying the petition of William F. Doyle and others relative to the salaries of the firemen and other employees in the State House. Public Service. January 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Firemen and Other Laborers employed
in the State House.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salaries of the firemen employed
2 in the state house shall be one thousand dollars a
3 year and the salaries of the cleaners eight hundred
4 dollars a year, to be so allowed from the first day of
5 December, nineteen hundred and thirteen.

1 SECTION 2. The employees in the state house here-
2 tofore known as laborers and cleaners shall here-
3 after be known as helpers.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
