

Bill accompanying the petition of E. Ellsworth Lincoln for an extension of the time for the establishment of the Dighton Water Supply District. Water Supply. January 19.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To extend the Time for Establishing the Dighton Water Supply District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fourteen of chapter two hundred and twenty-
2 six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and eleven
3 is hereby amended by striking out the word "three", in
4 the seventh line, and inserting in place thereof the word:
5 — six, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 14.* This
6 act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a majority
7 vote of the voters of said district present and voting
8 thereon by ballot at any legal district meeting called for
9 the purpose within three months after the passage of this
10 act; but it shall become void unless the said district shall
11 begin to distribute water through its pipes to consumers
12 in said Dighton water supply district within six years
13 after the date of the acceptance of this act as aforesaid.
