SPECIAL RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE TRUSTEES OF MEDFIELD STATE ASYLUM.

The present administration building, where there is a small dispensary, and where the steward resides, is much crowded. Extra space is needed in this building. The trustees therefore request an appropriation of \$30,000 to erect a two-story brick building for use as a dispensary, the second floor of which will be used as a hospital for contagious diseases, and also for a hospital for sick employees. At present there are 400 employees at Medfield, and there is no suitable place for isolating a contagious case or for caring for sick employees.

An appropriation of \$5,000 is also requested to construct a cottage for the steward and family. This estimate comprises the necessary furniture.

RESOLVE

To provide for Certain Improvements at the Medfield State
Asylum.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding thirty-
3 five thousand dollars, to be expended under the direction
4 of the trustees of the Medfield state asylum, for the fol-
5 lowing purposes:— For constructing and furnishing
6 dispensary building, a sum not exceeding thirty thousand
7 dollars; for constructing and furnishing a cottage for the
8 steward, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars.
