Bill accompanying the petition of John F. Sullivan for vacations for laborers and clerks in the employ of the city of Boston. Cities. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to Vacations for Certain Employees of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department heads of the city of Bos-
2 ton shall provide that all persons who, for a period of
3 not less than one year, have been employed in the respec-
4 tive departments, either as laborers or at clerical work,
5 shall be allowed a vacation for a period of not less than
6 two weeks without loss of pay, during such portions of
7 the year as said department heads may determine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
