

Bill accompanying the petition of William H. Marnell relative to transfer cards for school children. Education. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to Transfer Cards for Public School Pupils changing their Residences.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. When any child, required by section one
2 of chapter seven hundred and seventy-nine of the acts
3 of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen to attend
4 school, is being educated in any public or private school
5 or in any institution in any city or town, and leaves such
6 school or institution because of change of residence to
7 another city or town in the commonwealth, the superin-
8 tendent of schools, if the child attend a public school,
9 and the person in charge, if the child attend a private
10 school or is being educated in any institution, shall fur-
11 nish to such child a transfer card giving the name of
12 the child, his age, his grade in school, and in every case
13 possible, the street and number of his new residence, and
14 shall send without delay, a similar transfer card to the
15 superintendent of schools of the city or town in which
16 the child is to reside.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
