## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Granting of Fishing Privileges in Taunton Great River and to the Appointment of Fish Wardens by the City of Fall River.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fall River is not required to  
2 sell at public auction or at private sale the privileges of  
3 taking shad and alewives in Taunton Great river, or any  
4 other fishing privileges, unless the city council of said  
5 city shall order and direct such sale, which sale may then  
6 be made in such manner as said city council may order  
7 or direct.

1 SECTION 2. Said city of Fall River is not required  
2 to choose, elect or appoint fish wardens and no fish ward-  
3 ens shall be chosen, elected or appointed in any year.

1 SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall prevent the city  
 2 council of said city from selling said fishing privileges  
 3 or choosing, electing or appointing fish wardens, if said  
 4 city council shall consider the same advisable.

1 SECTION 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent  
 2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
