

HOUSE No. 1160

Bill accompanying the petition of the Roxbury Historical Society relative to the income of a certain fund of said society. Mercantile Affairs. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Income of a Certain Fund of the Roxbury Historical Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter two hundred
2 and fifty of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and
3 seventy-four, as amended by chapter one hundred and
4 five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and eleven,
5 is hereby further amended by adding at the end of said
6 section the words:— and the income of said surplus to
7 be devoted to the maintenance of said Roxbury Historical
8 Society,— so that said section shall read as follows:—
9 *Section 3.* Upon the completion of said monument said
10 corporation may convey the same and all the property
11 held by said corporation to the Roxbury Historical So-

12 ciety, together with any surplus of the fund raised for
 13 the erection of said monument; such surplus to be de-
 14 voted to the maintenance of said monument and the
 15 repairs, adornment and enlargement of the grounds about
 16 the same, and the income of such surplus to be devoted
 17 to the maintenance of said Roxbury Historical Society.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

 erection of a monument in the town of Roxbury
 in honor of the soldiers of the American Revolution
 who were killed in the battle of the Clouds
 on the 23d of June, 1780, and for other purposes
 relating to the same.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
 in the year one thousand nine hundred and

1. The Roxbury Historical Society, organized under the
 provisions of chapter two hundred and thirty
 and thirty-five of the Acts of the Commonwealth,
 is authorized to accept of the gift of the land
 described in the schedule annexed to this act,
 and to use the same for the purposes herein
 provided.

2. The land described in the schedule annexed to
 this act shall be conveyed to the Roxbury Historical
 Society, and the same shall be held in trust
 for the purposes herein provided.

3. The Roxbury Historical Society shall have the
 right to erect a monument on the land so
 conveyed, and to use the same for the purposes
 herein provided.

4. The Roxbury Historical Society shall have the
 right to use the income of the fund raised for
 the erection of said monument, and the surplus
 of such fund, for the maintenance of said
 monument and the repairs, adornment and
 enlargement of the grounds about the same,
 and the income of such surplus shall be devoted
 to the maintenance of said Roxbury Historical
 Society.
