AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Board of Registration
in Pharmacy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 salaries and expenses of the board of registration
5 in pharmacy, for the fiscal year ending on the thir-
6 tieth day of November, nineteen hundred and four-
7 teen, to wit:—

8 For the salaries of the members, thirty-one hun-
9 dred dollars. (Acts 1902, ch. 505; 1907, ch. 399;
10 1909, ch. 261.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$3,100.)

11 For traveling and other expenses of the members.
12 a sum not exceeding fourteen hundred and twenty-
13 five dollars. (Acts 1902, ch. 505.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$1,725.)

14 For salaries and expenses of the agent, a sum not
15 exceeding twenty-four hundred dollars. (Acts
16 1902, ch. 505.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$2,400.)

17 For a stenographer, witness fees and incidental and
18 contingent expenses, to include printing the annual
19 report, a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars.
20 (Acts 1902, chs. 438, 505.)

(Appropriation 1913, \$2,000.)

21 For expenses in connection with the act to pro-
22 vide for registering and licensing of stores for the
23 transaction of a retail drug business, a sum not ex-
24 ceeding one thousand dollars. (Acts 1913, ch. 705.)

(No appropriation 1913.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
