

HOUSE No. 1344

Bill accompanying the petition of William L. F. Gilman for the widening of Hyde Park avenue in the Hyde Park district of the city of Boston. Municipal Finance. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Widening of Hyde Park Avenue in the Hyde Park District of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of street commissioners of the
2 city of Boston may, in that part of Boston which was
3 formerly the town of Hyde Park, widen Hyde Park
4 avenue, from Metropolitan avenue to River street, to a
5 width not exceeding eighty-five feet, as a highway, and
6 with a suitable drainage system together with suitable
7 sidewalks, edgestones, gutters, culverts and catch basins,
8 and in accordance with such lay out may make necessary
9 takings of property.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of meeting the expendi-
2 tures authorized by this act to be made, the treasurer of

3 the said city of Boston is hereby authorized to issue
 4 bonds to an amount not exceeding three hundred thou-
 5 sand dollars for a term not exceeding thirty years, as an
 6 addition to all sums heretofore authorized by general or
 7 special laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT

To provide for the widening of State Street in the
 City of Boston.
 It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
 in lawful session assembled, and by the authority of the
 Senate, as follows:
 SECTION 1. The Board of Street Commissioners of the
 City of Boston may, in that part of Boston which was
 formerly the town of North Boston, within High Street
 from North Street to State Street, to a
 width not exceeding eighty feet on a highway, and
 with a suitable drainage system, together with suitable
 sidewalks, sidewalks, gutters, curbs and other things
 and to acquire any lands for the same under necessary
 powers of eminent domain.
 SECTION 2. For the purpose of widening the highway
 as above authorized by this act, the following is
