

HOUSE No. 1349

Bill accompanying the petition of Edwin F. Dwelley for the abatement of the nuisance caused by the discharge of sewage by the city of Lynn into tide waters. Public Health. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for Abating the Sewage Nuisance caused by the
City of Lynn.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lynn is hereby authorized to
2 borrow the sum of one million five hundred thousand
3 dollars for the purpose of meeting the expenses incurred
4 under the provisions of this act in abating the sewage
5 nuisance caused by the city of Lynn through the dis-
6 charge of its sewage into the tide waters of the common-
7 wealth.

1 SECTION 2. The state board of health shall prepare
2 plans, let contracts and generally and wholly supervise
3 and direct the work of abating said nuisance.

1 SECTION 3. The city of Lynn shall pay into the treas-
 2 ury of the commonwealth such sums, up to the aggregate
 3 amount of one million five hundred thousand dollars, and
 4 at such times as the auditor of the commonwealth may
 5 determine as necessary to meet expenses incurred by the
 6 state board of health under this act.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
