### RESOLVE

Relative to the Erection of a Memorial to John Brown of  
Rehoboth.

1 *Resolved*, That a commission of three persons, to be  
2 appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent  
3 of the council, shall consider the advisability of erecting  
4 a memorial or of joining with certain residents of the  
5 state of Rhode Island in erecting a memorial to John  
6 Brown, a leader in colonial affairs, the founder of the  
7 town of Rehoboth, assistant to the governor of Plymouth  
8 for seventeen years, and a commissioner of Plymouth  
9 colony for twelve years. The commission shall report to  
10 the general court, with such recommendations as it may  
11 deem expedient, not later than the first day of May in  
12 the current year.
