

HOUSE No. 1411

Bill accompanying the petition of Bernard J. Golden for a revision of the charter of the city of Woburn. Cities. January 22.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for a Commissioner of Public Works for the City of Woburn.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That chapter one hundred and
2 seventy-two of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
3 and ninety-seven, and any acts in amendment
4 thereof, shall be revised in so much as refers to the
5 board of public works of the said city of Woburn,
6 by striking out all such references to the board of
7 public works, and inserting in its place the follow-
8 ing.

1 SECTION 2. The mayor of said city of Woburn
2 shall appoint a commissioner of public works who
3 shall be a civil engineer, for a term of three years,

4 subject to the civil service rules of this common-
5 wealth, at such salary as the city council may deter-
6 mine, and said appointment shall not be subject to
7 confirmation.

1 SECTION 3. All powers now vested in the said
2 board of public works are hereby vested in the said
3 commissioner of public works, and said commissioner
4 may be removed by the mayor according to the civil
5 service rules of this commonwealth.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall be submitted to the
2 voters of the said city of Woburn at the next state
3 election, and if a majority of the registered voters
4 voting at said election shall declare in the affirma-
5 tive, this act shall go into effect the first Monday in
6 January, nineteen hundred and fifteen.
