Bill accompanying the petition of Irving F. Gibbs and others for the improvement of Cataumet Harbor and Squeteague Pond in the towns of Falmouth and Bourne. Harbors and Public Lands. January 22.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Improvement of Cataumet Harbor and Squeteague Pond in the Towns of Falmouth and Bourne.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of harbor and land commis-
2 sioners is hereby authorized and directed to improve
3 Cataumet harbor and Squeteague pond in the towns
4 of Falmouth and Bourne, in Barnstable county, by
5 excavating and constructing a channel of suitable
6 width and depth in said harbor and extending into
7 Squeteague pond, and by excavating a suitable
8 anchorage basin for boats and vessels adjacent to
9 said channel; and for this purpose may expend a

10 sum not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars, to
 11 be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth,
 12 together with such other sums as may be contributed
 13 from other sources.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
 2 passage.

AN ACT

To provide for the improvement of Cataumet Harbor and adjacent pond in the Town of Palmyra and Bourne.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in lawful session, that the authority of the Board, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The Board of Harbor and Land Com-
- 2 missioners is hereby authorized and directed to improve
- 3 Cataumet Harbor and adjacent pond in the town
- 4 of Palmyra and Bourne in Harbortable county, by
- 5 excavating and widening a channel of suitable
- 6 width and depth in said harbor and adjoining
- 7 Harbortable pond, and by reconstructing a suitable
- 8 anchorage basin for boats and vessels adjacent to
- 9 said channel; and for this purpose may acquire a
